The **monthly prayer meeting**, specifically to pray for healing, will be held on 10<sup>th</sup> June.

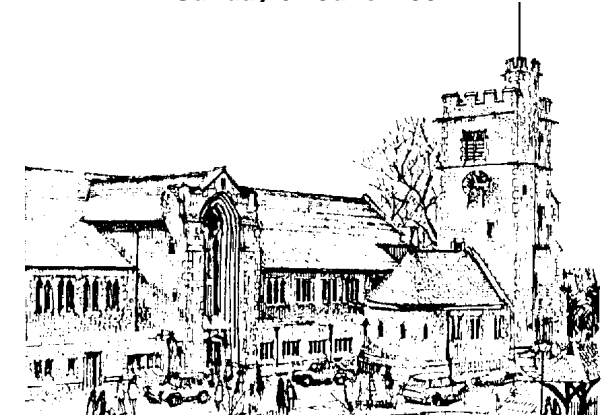
