On Maundy Thursday there will be an informal; celebration of the Eucharist in the context of a Passover meal at 8pm..

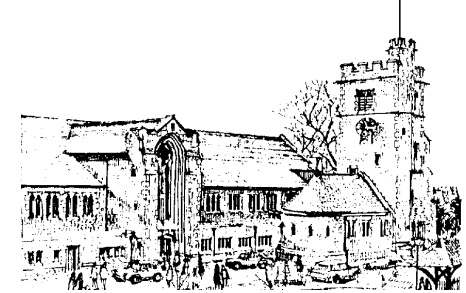
Jus B are moving to new office premises and would like some help, if you could help anytime on 7th – 10th April please contact Anne Yolland, 0208 460 9204.
