In the past we were able to make a small profit by arranging the flowers for weddings held in the Church but parties are understandably reluctant these days to spend more than necessary and during 2004 the only income from this source was £20 towards the cost of the altar pedestal.

Maureen Woods continues enthusiastically to organise the sale of books on our behalf and we are most grateful for the £50.50 she has raised in this way.

While we would still welcome more arrangers for the flower rota, we have been encouraged by the help forthcoming for decorating the Church at the special festivals.

On Saturday 11th June 2005 we hope to take part in the 'Come Celebrate Creation' day with demonstrations of flower arranging.
