In recent years the church has received a large number of bequests. These have been used in a variety of ways to improve the church. For example May Steven's bequest has been set aside to pay for the painting of the mural in the Children's Chapel.

At November's PCC meeting it was felt that the PCC should publicise how these bequests are being used and that a record of the 'gifts' given to the church should be kept. It would seem that the best way to do this would be to update the Book of Donors. However this has not been done for numerous years although the wardens have kept a record of new 'fixtures' as part of the inventory.

Probably the only way to discover what gifts have been given to the church is to look back through past parish magazines and the PCC minutes. This is a large task but one which a member of the church may like to undertake. If you feel that you have the time and the eyesight to do this research, please let me know.

Scottish Dance & Social.

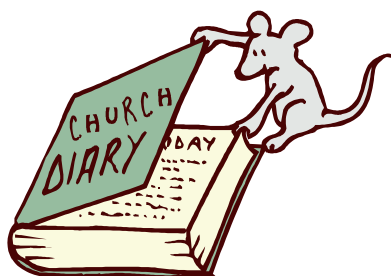
