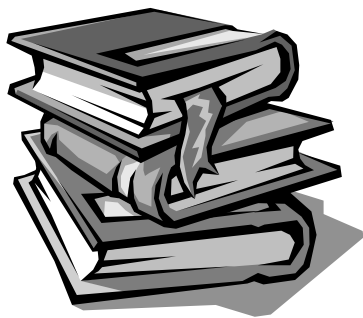


Book Reviews
