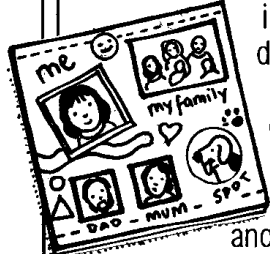


MOUSE HOLE

Collect together photos from a special event like a birthday or day out. Stick onto a sheet of card in an interesting design. Add decoration and lettering and write on:

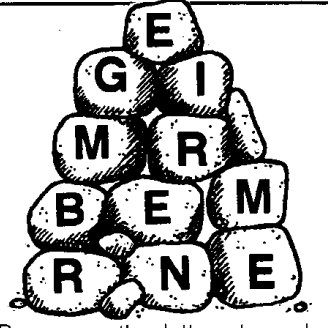


WHO is in the photo, WHAT is happening, WHERE and WHEN it was.

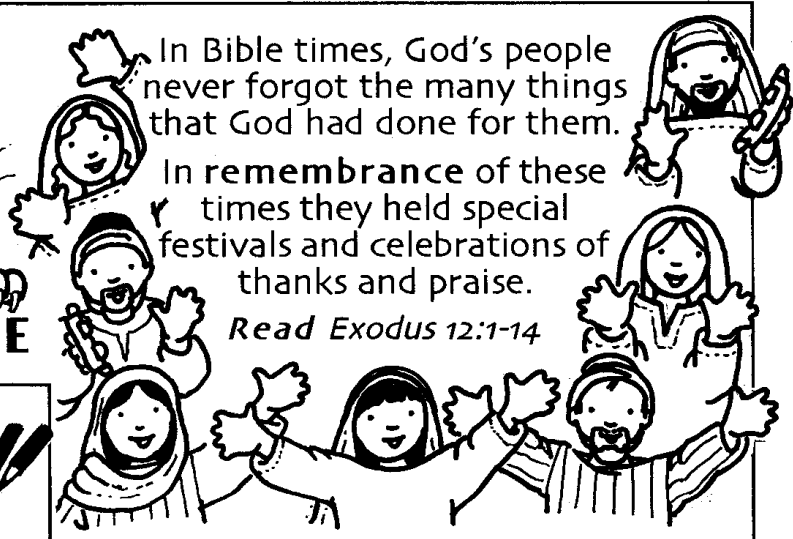


You can buy 12"x12" 'Scrapbook' albums and card from craft shops.

Rearrange the letters to make a word, then see how many other words you can make.



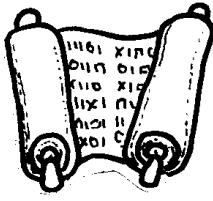
In Bible times, God's people never forgot the many things that God had done for them.

Read Exodus 12:1-14

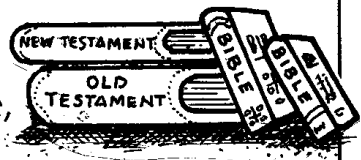
Sometimes large piles of stones were built as monuments to remember what God had done...
