- Place:** Downham Way, a few minutes walk from Grove Park Station
- Open:** 2nd Friday in the month. 12.15pm till 2pm
- Details:** Staffed by volunteers. Recommended by many friends, I visited, registered, and was most warmly welcomed into the church proper, where I sat at an attractively decorated table with seven other friends.
