Four Saxes play 'Renaissance to Ragtime - Baroque to Blues'

River City Saxes is a saxophone quartet that plays music ranging from classical and contemporary works to light music and swing. Formed in October 2008, the quartet has fulfilled many engagements across London and Surrey, and is currently presenting a series of lunchtime recitals in London churches.

Chris Hooker - Soprano Saxophone is the leader of the quartet, Chris's career has been in Music Education. He now devotes his time to playing, arranging, and conducting.

Bob Lowdell - Alto Saxophone - After studying Clarinet and Saxophone at the Guildhall School of Music, Bob played professionally in theatre pit orchestras up and down the country.

Martyn Thomas - Tenor Saxophone - has played with many well known groups in the South London / Surrey area in the last 30 years including the Central Band of the Royal British Legion.

Geoff Williams - Baritone Saxophone - Geoff studied flute at the Royal College of Music, and was a founder member of the London Saxophone Quartet from 1968 to 1970 before joining the Joe Loss Orchestra in 1972. He has played in many West End shows
